I've highlighted the case for pay equality in national and local media, to T.D.s and Senators in Leinster House, at meetings of New Entrant teachers and at meetings of INTO National Committees, Districts and Branches. I'm determined to deliver one single pay scale with restoration of teachers' pay to 2008 levels.

Equal Treatment For Primary Education Is Right and Proper

I have used every public opportunity to demand equality of provision between Primary and Secondary Education - equal remuneration for primary school leaders and equal treatment for all primary pupils. I have called for the re-instatement of promotional posts, lower class sizes, additional support for children with special educational needs and increased primary school capitation.

Teaching Council Must Improve Our Professional Lives

I chaired the first meeting of primary teachers newly elected to the Teaching Council. I implored those elected to work towards a non-judgemental Teacher Induction Scheme giving due recognition to the longer pre-service courses and bringing an end to the current system of probation. I also asked them to ensure that the new council strongly supports the profession in public. Council decisions must not lead to an increase in teacher workload or to a lowering of members morale.

I have met with our Northern Committee and have promised them my total support for their campaign for the payment of the overdue pay award, for the early implementation of the Investment In Teaching Workforce Scheme and for their Industrial action on workload issues.

Committee Work Crucial

I firmly believe in the power of committee work. I addressed and offered my support to our Equality Committee, Education Committee and Principals & Deputy Principals Committee. I chaired meetings of our Central Executive Committee and of various sub-committees. I have continued to serve on the Board of Comhar Linn INTO Credit Union and on the Club Na Múinteoirí Committee. I played a central role in formulating the INTO response for the consultation on the Dept. of Education & Skills Strategic Plan.

Real Choice of Schooling Vital

I welcomed the government commitment to increase the number of multi-denominational and non-denominational schools. I have listened to the concerns of our members in Community National Schools and have negotiated on their behalf with the Department of Education & Skills and with their proposed new patron-ETB Ireland.
